Why King's?

Classes led by outstanding faculty are central to the King's experience. Class sizes at King's are small by university standards. King's students are Western students and have complete access to all the facilities, services, and athletics at Western. They can take some of their courses at Western's main campus, or at one of the other affiliated university colleges: Brescia or Huron. Most importantly, **King's students graduate with a Western degree.**

Pathway to King's

Students graduating from Fanshawe's **Social Services Worker (SSW)** diploma with a **minimum 3.5 GPA** will be considered for admission to year three of King's Bachelor of Social Work (BSW).

Admissions Requirements

- Graduate of Fanshawe's SSW diploma
- Completion of SSW diploma within two years of applying to the BSW
- Minimum Cumulative GPA of 3.5
- No grade less than "C" (or 2.0 GPA)
- Letter of Endorsement from the Chair of the School of Community Studies

College Entrance Scholarships

King's University College offers an unlimited number of CAAT Entrance Scholarships to qualified applicants. Students must remain registered in 4.0 courses and meet King's residency requirements. Averages and scholarship amounts are listed below.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Apply

Online applications are available at the Ontario Universities' Application Centre's Web site: ouac.on.ca. For College transfer applicants, please use the OUAC's 105 application. If you have any questions about the application procedure, please contact the OUAC at 519-823-1063.

2. Submit Documents

- Your mid-year Fanshawe transcript (unless sent through OUAC)
- Your final high school transcript
- Any other documents requested by King's

3. Obtain Letter of Endorsement

4. Apply to the School of Social Work

To be considered for admission for year 3 in the BSW, you must complete a formal application by **March 15th**. Further instructions on how to apply can be found at socialwork.kings.uwo.ca/bsw/how-to-apply.

FAQS

How Many Transfer Credit Will I receive?

You may receive 8.0 credits. Students need to complete 10.0 credits prior to registration in year three of the BSW. Students in this path need to complete 2.0 credits (0.5 Writing 1020 f/g and 1.0 Science credit, 0.5 elective) at King's in the May-July term prior to their September registration.

Can I Apply to an Alternate Degree Program?

Students are able to pursue degrees in other disciplines. The maximum credit granted to students applying from the SSW diploma to other programs is 5.0 credits. For this path, students must achieve a minimum 3.0 CPA (B) on their diploma with no grade less than C.

NEXT STEPS

1. Accept Your Offer

Once you have received an offer from King's, please accept your offer on the OUAC 105 by the deadline noted on your offer letter.

2. Meet Your Admissions Conditions

If you are in progress in your Fanshawe program and have received a conditional offer, you must meet the conditions listed in your offer.

3. Submit Your Final Transcripts

Once you have completed your diploma, please forward your final Fanshawe transcript to King's Enrolment Services. Once received, King's will finalize your transfer credit and scholarship eligibility.

4. Register for summer courses

How Do I Register for the Required Summer Courses?

If you are admitted to King's, we will assist you with enrolling for summer courses. Summer registration begins the first week of March on a first-come, first-serve basis. We recommend applying early to Kings' to allow for timely summer enrolment. Please contact Julie Siversns, Social Work Program Assistant at Julie.siversns@kings.uwo.ca for assistance.
