PATHWAY TO KING'S

Students graduating from Lambton's Social Services Worker (SSW) diploma with a minimum 3.5 GPA will be considered for admission to year three of King's Bachelor of Social Work (BSW).

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Graduate from Lambton's SSW Diploma
- Completion of SSW diploma within two years of applying to the BSW program
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5
- No grade less than "C" (or 2.0 GPA)
- Letter of Endorsement from the Coordinator of the Social Services Worker Program

COLLEGE ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS

King's University College offers an unlimited number of CAAT Entrance Scholarships to qualified applicants. Students must remain registered in 4.0 courses and meet King's residency requirements. Averages and scholarship amounts are listed below.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Apply

Online applications are available at the Ontario Universities' Application Centre's website: www.ouac.on.ca. If you have any questions about the application procedure, please contact the OUAC at 519-823-1063.

2. Submit Documents

- Your mid-year Lambton transcript (unless sent through OUAC)
- Your final high school transcript
- Any other documents requested by King's

3. Obtain Letter of Endorsement

4. Apply to the School of Social Work

To be considered for admission for year 3 in the BSW, you must complete a formal application by **March 15th**. Further instructions on how to apply can be found at socialwork.kings.uwo.ca/bsw/how-to-apply

FAQS

How many transfer credits will I receive?

You may receive 7.5 credits. Students need to complete 10.0 credits prior to registration in year three of the BSW. Students on this path need to complete 2.5 credits (1.0 Science, 0.5 Research Methods (SOC 2206 A/B) or equivalent, 0.5 Arts/Humanities, 0.5 elective) at King's in the May-July term prior to their September registration.

Can I apply to an alternate degree program?

Students are able to pursue degrees in other disciplines. The maximum credit granted to students applying from the SSW diploma to other programs is 5.0 credits. For this path, students must achieve a minimum 3.0 CPA ("B") on their diploma with no grade less than "C."

NEXT STEPS

1. Accept Your Offer

Once you have received an offer, please accept your offer through the OUAC by the deadline noted on your offer letter.

- **2. Meet your Admissions Conditions** If you are in progress in your Lambton program and have received a conditional offer, you must meet the conditions listed in your offer.
- 3. Submit Your Final Transcript Once you have completed your diploma, please forward your final Lambton transcript to King's Enrolment Services. Once received, King's will finalize your transfer credit and scholarship eligibility.

4. Register For Summer Courses

If you are admitted to King's, we will assist you with enrolling for summer courses. Summer registration begins the first week of March on a first-come, first-serve basis. We recommend applying early to King's to allow for timely summer enrolment. Please contact socialwork@kings.uwo.ca
